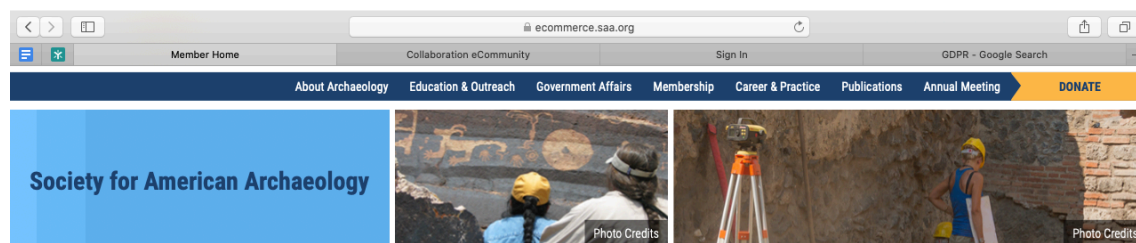
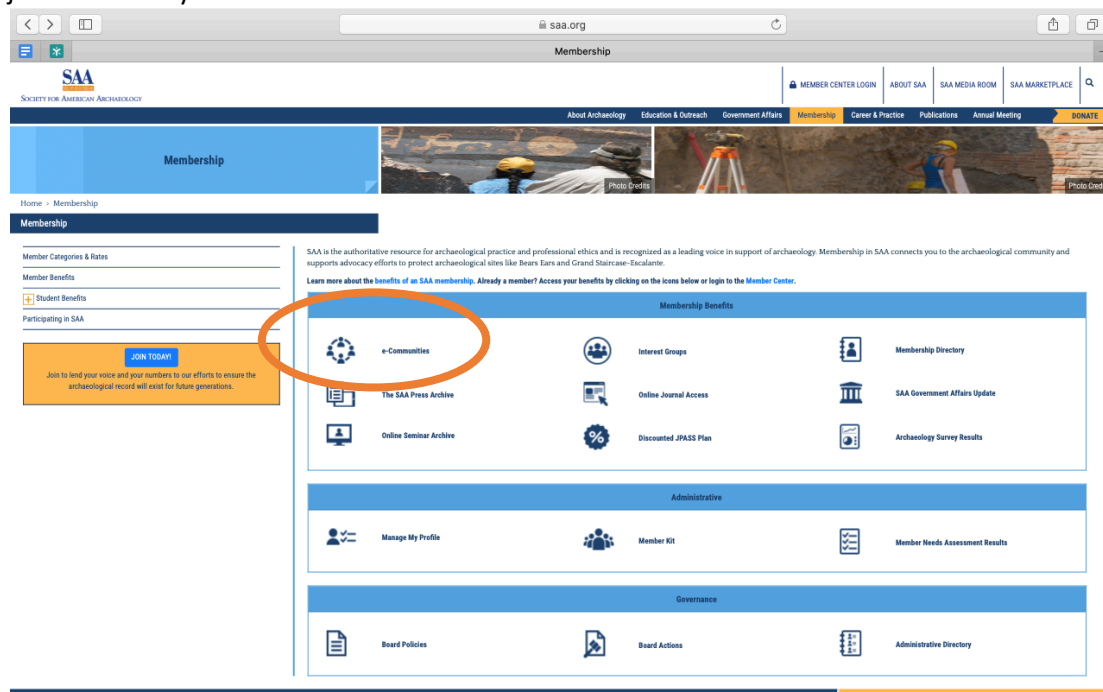


Connecting with Others for Annual Meeting Session

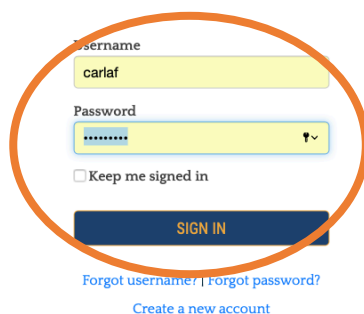




